General Petraeus, whose military career spanned over 37 years, concluded his service with six consecutive commands as a general officer, five of which were in combat zones. Notable commands included leading the Surge in Iraq, U.S. Central Command, and Coalition Forces in Afghanistan. Following his military career, General Petraeus served as the Director of the CIA during a period marked by significant achievements in the war on terror.

In addition to his military achievements, General Petraeus became a Partner at KKR, a Strategic Advisor for Semperis, and served on the boards of Optiv and OneStream. He was also actively involved in academic endeavors, holding appointments at institutions such as Yale, Harvard, Georgetown, and the University of Southern California. General Petraeus became a Senior Fellow and Lecturer at Yale and an Honorary Professor at the University of Birmingham (UK).

General Petraeus, in collaboration with Andrew Roberts, released a book titled "Conflict: The Evolution of Warfare from 1945 to Ukraine." The book was exclusively available for sale and signature to all those who attended the event.
