Uruguayan Ambassador Andrés Augusto Durán Hareau Speaks to The University Club of Washington, DC

WASHINGTON, D.C., December 20, 2023 - The University Club of Washington, DC today hosted Ambassador Andrés Augusto Durán Hareau, the esteemed former Ambassador of Uruguay to the U.S., appointed by President Luis Lacalle Pou in September 2020.

Ambassador Durán has over 20 years of experience in the private sector, where he held key roles in general management and corporate legal advisory capacities. His expertise spanned significant foreign investment projects, mergers and acquisitions, and financial transactions throughout Latin America.

Ambassador Durán served as an executive advisor for Latin America in the private equity and real estate division of Ashmore Group. Then from 2018 to 2020, he played a pivotal role in leading M&A and financial restructuring transactions in Latin America, while also fostering coordination between the company's New York and Bogotá offices.

Ambassador Durán co-founded the law firm Bragard & Durán in Uruguay from 2011 to 2018. His legal career also included roles as a partner and associate at the law firm Hughes & Hughes (1998-2011; Uruguay) and a visiting attorney at Slaughter and May (2008, London). He contributed to the legal division of the Inter-American Investment Corporation (currently IDB Invest) in Washington DC in 2002.

A distinguished scholar, Ambassador Durán holds a J.D. from the Catholic University of Uruguay and an LL.M. in International Legal Studies from the Georgetown University Law Center, where he



graduated with distinction as a Fulbright scholar. In addition, he earned an MBA from the MIT Sloan School of Management as a Sloan Fellow.
