Currently serving as Pakistan's Ambassador to the US, Ambassador Khan previously was President of Azad Jammu and Kashmir from 2016-2021.

At the UN, he represented Pakistan on the Security Council 2012-2013, serving as President in January 2013. He held leadership roles as Vice President of the UN General Assembly, Vice President of the Economic and Social Council, and President of UNICEF's Executive Board.

Ambassador Khan spearheaded Pakistan's delegations addressing internet governance, biological weapons, and nuclear security. His expertise in nuclear diplomacy led to his service as Pakistan's Chief Negotiator during the US-led Nuclear Security Summits from 2009 to 2015.

Before embarking on his diplomatic career, Ambassador Khan engaged global audiences as a TV host, radio newscaster, and sought-after lecturer at key universities and think tanks in the US and abroad.
